

## Course Objectives

1. Describe the characteristics of life-threatening illness and injury in children.
2. Identify the anatomic and physiologic characteristics of children as a basis for signs and symptoms.
3. Identify the most frequent causes of illness or injury in children.
4. Describe the assessment or pediatric patients with illness or injury.
5. Plan the specific interventions needed to manage the pediatric patient with illness or injury.
6. Evaluate the effectiveness of nursing interventions related to patient outcomes.
7. Identify health promotion strategies related to the pediatric population.
8. Identify misconceptions regarding the assessment and treatment of pain in pediatric patients in the emergency department.
9. Describe the four phases of emergency management.

## Course Overview

The Emergency Nursing Pediatric Course was developed by the Emergency Nurses Association. It is designed to provide core-level trauma knowledge and psychomotor skills associated with the delivery of professional nursing care to the trauma patient. The content is presented through lectures and psychomotor skill stations.
