Patricia was an avid trout fisherman and shared a great sense of humor with those around her. Her mother, Beverly, laughs that "We always treated her as our own family doctor for questions about this or that."

When faced with the challenges of illness and the need for constant oxygen, Patricia purchased a Segway to help her get around. Figuring out how to balance the oxygen tank between her feet on the Segway is another example of how she wouldn't let obstacles slow her down. Patricia passed away at 57 years of age.
