When Patrick Colwell graduated from Cedar Falls High School in the mid 1970s, he considered two career paths: technology and nursing. Since there were few male nurses in the health care industry at that time, Colwell was nudged into the technology field.

Pat never lost his passion for helping people. So, he decided in his mid 40s to resign his job as a systems analyst for Deere & Company to enroll at Allen College. Though he left a well-paying job, his decision to enter the nursing field paid off in two ways.

First, his father, Bill, a long-time area automobile dealer, was stricken with lung cancer. Pat was able to use the knowledge he gained at Allen College to comfort his father and the rest of his family. Shortly after Bill died in 2001, Pat earned his bachelor of science in nursing degree from Allen, and is now living his dream of being a nurse at Allen Hospital.

Bill and Marcia Colwell grew up in Illinois and moved to Cedar Falls in 1967. In addition to his auto business, Bill Colwell also raised elk and trumpeter swans. Marcia still lives in Waterloo and has two other sons, Bill Jr. and Michael. Pat's wife, Marty, worked in the administration office at Allen Hospital.
