This scholarship was established by Oscar Lanich, M.D., to assist a needy and deserving person to pursue a career in the Allen College radiography program. It is based on scholastic achievement, financial need and personal qualifications.

Dr. Lanich was born in Philipsburg, Pennsylvania. He attended St. Joseph's College and Jefferson Medical College, both in Philadelphia, receiving his medical degree in 1946. He completed his internship at Thomas Fitzgerald Mercy Hospital in Darby, Pennsylvania.

Following two years in the U.S. Army, he entered general practice at Taylor Hospital and later completed his Radiology Residency at Thomas Fitzgerald Mercy Hospital. He was in general practice from 1947 to 1954, and radiology from 1954 to 1984.

Dr. Lanich was certified by the American Board of Radiology. He was appointed to the medical staff of Allen Memorial Hospital in 1959 and was a radiologist in Radiology Services at Allen Memorial Hospital until his retirement in 1984.

Anne was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Dr. Lanich and Anne met in West Philly while he was playing piano in a band. Years later after medical school they were married and they had two children. Dr. Lanich and Anne enjoyed walking together, playing bridge and spending time with their grandchildren.

His favorite holiday was St. Patrick's Day because he loves Irish tradition and appreciates his Irish ancestry.

Dr. Lanich passed away in 2006 and Anne passed away in 2024.
