Alice and Quinter Lichty were active supporters of Allen College and Allen Hospital, where four of their five children were delivered. Throughout their 58 years of marriage, they appreciated a personal friendship with and the medical service of Dr. Russell Gerard. "He made it the hospital for us," said Alice.

The Lichty's were life-long farmers in Orange Township and were members of South Waterloo Church of the Brethren. After retiring, they lived in Orange Center and later at Friendship Village. They appreciated students' dedication to pursuing a medical education and understood the financial challenges that often accompany that pursuit. For that reason, when Quinter died in 2006, Alice endowed this scholarship to honor her husband. After Alice passed away in 2020, an additional gift was received to triple the endowment.
