

Course Overview

The Trauma Nursing Core Course was designed by the Emergency Nurses Association in response to the need for an organized, systematic approach to the initial care of trauma patients. The course content is organized to provide the student with the knowledge necessary to provide care of the trauma patient through lecture and demonstration of the trauma nursing process.

Participants are given the opportunity to practice the psychomotor skills prior to evaluation. Evaluation includes a written exam to assess the learner's knowledge of the content presented in lecture and in the course materials, as well as demonstration of the trauma nursing process.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of this program, the participant should be able to:

- Describe nursing assessment, nursing diagnosis, planning, implementation and evaluation as related to the nursing care of trauma patients.
- Discuss the scope of injury, shock management, multiple trauma, assessment and intervention, primary and secondary survey, triage priorities and patient education as related to trauma patients.
- Describe and demonstrate airway management, multiple trauma assessment, multiple trauma intervention, spinal immobilization, and splinting.

INTENDED AUDIENCE

This course is intended for licensed registered nurses who work in the emergency care setting and care for patients sustaining traumatic injuries. Other health care providers may audit the course on a space-available basis without receipt of verification from the Emergency Nurses Association.

CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS
