Grammarly has made some exciting enhancements that will enable you to use this resource when writing in Microsoft Word, in Internet browsers, in emails, and on the desktop.

You can always access Grammarly online without having to download any products. To do that, log in to the Grammarly editor using your login credentials.

The MS Office plug-in conveniently adds Grammarly to Microsoft Word and Microsoft Outlook. A Grammarly tab at the top of the page allows you to enable/disable Grammarly as you wish whenever you are in a Word document. When enabled, Grammarly will appear on the right-hand side and provide real-time suggestions for corrections as you write. These corrections are similar to what you see in the online-editor version of Grammarly, including the availability of tutorials to help you to understand how to avoid the error.
