Job runs during June and July. Health Officer will be expected on site when campers are present.

- ***Preferred: CPR, AED, First Aid Certified***
- Provide for the health and safety needs of the camp.
- The Health Officer alerts the Camp Director to any unsafe actions or conditions of the campers or camp - specific responsibilities are:
- Be particularly alert to conditions that affect health, safety, sanitation, and good housekeeping practices.
- Work in conjunction with the camp physician and local hospital.
- Maintain a daily sick call and first aid treatment center.
- Conduct the weekly medical recheck of each camper and issue buddy tags.
- Maintain daily and accurate health log records of all occurrences involving the first aid center.
- Supervise the instruction of the merit badges that are being taught at or around the Health Lodge.
- Submit a final report of medical supplies needed and recommendations for the next summer.
- All other duties as assigned.

FRINGE BENEFITS

All Camp Staff will be provided with a small summer salary, on-site housing and 3 meals a day for the summer months. All jobs can also be offered as an internship for students.
