Allen College is seeking candidates for a full-time faculty position beginning August 2023 in the Master of Science in Occupational Therapy Program. The faculty member shall hold an academic faculty appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor or Associate Professor at Allen College consistent with his/her education, experience and qualifications of the rank. The faculty is a member of the Faculty Organization Committee at large and appointed to other faculty committees; is involved in the development and evaluation of the program and students enrolled; is actively involved in teaching in the classroom and/or clinical; provides guidance and academic advising of students at Allen College; and is supervised by the School's Dean. Academic rank is commensurate with education, post-secondary teaching experience and experience as an occupational therapist.

Qualifications

1. Minimum of a master's degree in occupational therapy from a regionally accredited institution of higher education. Doctoral degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher education in occupational therapy or related field preferred.
2. Some teaching experience in a full-time academic appointment with teaching responsibilities at the postsecondary level in the program discipline according to accreditation standards helpful. Three years of experience in an academic appointment preferred.
3. Licensed as an occupational therapist in Iowa (or ability to become licensed in Iowa) with a minimum of three years of clinical experience.
4. Evidence of involvement in professional activity and community service.
