## **Position Summary:**

The AmeriCorps member serving at Allen College will support and expand campus-wide civic engagement initiatives through the Center for Engagement, Learning, and Leadership (CELL). This position focuses on developing, coordinating, and promoting service-learning programs that enrich student learning, foster meaningful community partnerships, and address local needs.

## **Key Responsibilities:**

- 1. Collaborate closely with CELL staff to advance the Center's mission and programming.
- 2. Actively participate in the Allen College Community Service Committee.

- 3. Lead efforts to integrate service-learning into the academic environment as a valued component of teaching and student development.
- 4. Identify and cultivate partnerships with community-based organizations to serve as service-learning sites.
- 5. Serve as a resource to students by advising them on service-learning and civic engagement opportunities.
- 6. Facilitate connections between students and community agencies that promote multicultural awareness and community health.
- 7. Coordinate and oversee the logistics of student service-learning experiences, ensuring alignment with academic goals and community needs.
- 8. Represent Allen College at local, state, national and international events related to service-learning and civic engagement.
- 9. Foster cross-departmental collaboration to strengthen community engagement efforts across academic programs.
- 10. Promote awareness of community issues and how Allen College can address them through education and service initiatives.
- 11. Organize and support peer-led mentorship and volunteer programs related to service-learning.
- 12. Assist in tracking and coordinating students' completion of community benefit hours.
- 13. Uphold and model the mission, vision, values, and policies of Allen College in all service activities.
- 14. Demonstrate and promote the UnityPoint Health FOCUS Values and Standards of Behavior.
- 15. Navigate the physical and mental demands of the position, including managing deadlines, participating in meetings and engaging with faculty, staff, students and the public in a professional and positive manner.

## **Basic Eligibility:**

To comply with AmeriCorps guidelines and partnership goals, all applicants must meet the following basic eligibility requirements. Please certify that you meet the basic eligibility requirements:

- Be at least 18 years of age at the time of official enrollment, August 17, 2025.
- Have a high school diploma or its equivalent (or be in the process of obtaining one). College coursework, college degree or equivalent work experience preferred.
- Be a U.S. Citizen, national or lawful permanent resident alien of the United States.
- AmeriCorps requires a review of the National Sex Offender Public Registry, maintained by the
  Department of Justice, before an AmeriCorps applicant can be approved for service. Any applicant's
  records found on this registry will result in deselection.
- The AmeriCorps program will also conduct a comprehensive criminal history check on all candidates.
- You must submit required information to AmeriCorps and comply fully with this process or risk termination from service.
- Successful completion and clearance of required background checks including: 1) a nationwide National Sex Offender check; 2) a Statewide Criminal History check (including a state of residence check, if applicable)

# Salary & Benefits:

This is an AmeriCorps full-time (1700 hours) position. AmeriCorps members serving in a full-time position receive a living stipend totaling \$22,500, which is paid out bi-weekly at approximately \$900 per pay period (pre-tax). Payment is coordinated by AmeriCorps. Members also receive an education award to be used for qualified student loans and/or to pay current educational expenses. The education award for FY24 is \$7,395.
