A minimum of two years of documented experience in the field of occupational therapy which must include clinical practice experience as an occupational therapist or in the case of a non-OT applicant, a minimum of two years of documented practical experience in the applicant's profession (e.g. psychology, sociology, physical therapy, speech language pathology, etc.).
- 3. Current clinical skills and demonstrated competency in practice.
- 4. Documented experience in the areas of teaching responsibilities; knowledge of content delivery method is preferred. Teaching experience at a post-secondary level is preferred.
- 5. Demonstrated ability to do scholarly work.
- Licensed as an occupational therapist or in the case of a non-OT applicant, licensed or otherwise regulated in the appropriate profession (e.g. psychology, sociology, physical therapy, speech language pathology, etc.) in lowa (or ability to become licensed in lowa).
- 7. Evidence of involvement in professional activity and community service.
