Scholarship Guidelines

Application Deadline: May 1, 2024

Criteria:

- Applicant must be a woman student.
- Applicant must have completed at least one year of higher education by the end of the Spring 2024 semester.
- Applicant must plan to attend the University of Northern Iowa, Hawkeye Community College or Allen College (2024-2025) and enroll in at least 9 credit hours each semester. (Recipient will be required to provide verification of enrollment status at one of the above colleges.)
- Applicant must be pursuing a degree at the undergraduate level.
- Applicants will be considered without regard to race, creed, sexual orientation, national origin, age, socioeconomic status or disability.
- Priority may be given to applicants who show greatest financial need, who reside in Benton, Black Hawk, Bremer, Buchanan, Butler, Fayette, Grundy or Tama County who are majoring in a non-traditional field of study.
