SUBJECT: Pre-licensure Nursing Student Clinical Absence and Tardiness

PURPOSE: To provide a uniform method by which to address clinical absences and tardiness by

pre-licensure nursing students

EFFECTIVE

FOR: Undergraduate nursing faculty and students

POLICY/PROCEDURE:

1. Unexcused tardiness is defined as arriving any time beyond the expected designated clinical start time; unexcused absence is defined as any missed day of clinical that was not communicated with the clinical instructor in advance of the absence.

- a. Students who are tardy may be asked to leave the clinical unit and makeup the clinical hours as outlined in the clinical syllabus for each course.
- b. First occurrence of unexcused tardiness or clinical absence will result in the development of a clinical contract using a standardized form.
- c. This clinical contract will outline the expectations for successful completion of clinical and the consequences related to any subsequent unexcused tardiness or absence. Failure to successfully meet the expectations in the clinical contract may include clinical failure.
- d. This clinical contract will be placed in the student's advising folder.
- e. Individual patterns of behaviors will be addressed on a case-by-case basis.
- 2. Excused tardiness or absence is defined as any late arrival or missed day of clinical that is communicated with the clinical instructor in advance.
 - a. Any excused tardiness or clinical absence will result in the student being required to make up the clinical hours that were missed.
 - b. Subsequent excused instances of tardiness and/or absence will be addressed on a case-by-case basis and may result in clinical failure.
