She connected with Allen College later in life, enrolling in 1999 and quickly forming meaningful relationships with faculty and staff. Despite being diagnosed with neuroendocrine cancer in early 2000, Lynn remained committed to her studies and was honored with an honorary master's degree from Allen College before her passing in 2004 at age 57.

Together, Lynn and Stan envisioned a scholarship that would support nursing students who share Lynn's compassion and dedication to care. Stan continues to honor Lynn's legacy through this scholarship, helping students pursue their dreams in healthcare and carry forward the values Lynn held dear.
