The Shirley Bolton Llewellyn Memorial Endowed Scholarship was established through the estate of Dr. Jeffrey Llewellyn to honor the life and legacy of his mother, Shirley Bolton Llewellyn — a proud alumna of the Allen Memorial Hospital School of Nursing.

Shirley dedicated her career to nursing, serving patients for many years in a medical office in Cedar Falls. Beyond her professional life, she was deeply involved in her community, serving as a Cedar Falls City Council member and as an officer in both the Cedar Falls AMVETS Post 49 Auxiliary and the Iowa AMVETS Auxiliary. Her commitment to service, both in healthcare and civic life, left a lasting impact on those around her. Shirley passed away in 1998.

Dr. Jeffrey Llewellyn, a retired professor of biology at Brevard College in North Carolina, created this scholarship through his estate as a tribute to his mother's compassion and dedication. A passionate educator and scientist, Dr. Llewellyn earned his BA and MA from the University of Northern Iowa and his PhD from the University of Nevada, Reno. He was recognized with professor emeritus status and received numerous honors for his contributions to education and science. He was also an Eagle Scout and an active member of his community. Dr. Llewellyn passed away 2022.

Through this scholarship, Dr. Llewellyn sought to support future nursing students who share his mother's commitment to care and service. The scholarship was facilitated by his sister, Susan Llewellyn, trustee of his estate.
