

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Associate of Science in Radiography (ASR)

The ASR program begins once each year in a summer term (late July-early August). All required application materials must be received prior to admission consideration. Completed applicant files are reviewed on a rolling basis. The process requires three to four weeks.

High School Applicants (includes applicants with less than 25 college credits):

- Class rank: Upper 50% of graduating class or GED requirement
- Minimum high school cumulative grade point average of 3.0

Suggested course work:

English: 8 semesters (2 semesters composition)
Math: 6 semesters (2 semesters algebra)
Science: 6 semesters (2 semesters in biology)
Social Studies: 6 semesters

Transfer Applicants:

- Applicants with 1-24 earned college credits must meet High School Applicants criteria and have a minimum college cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Applicants with 25 or more earned college credits must have a minimum college cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- Earn a grade of C- or higher in all prescribed general education courses

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove [English proficiency](#) prior to admission consideration
