

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Associate of Science in Radiography (ASR)

The ASR program begins once each year in the summer (late July-early August). Applications will not be considered until all required materials are received. Complete applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. The review process requires six to eight weeks after file completion.

High School Applicants

Early Admission

The Early Admission process invites outstanding high school students to request admission. All admission criteria must be maintained. Early Admission applications are reviewed on a rolling basis.

- Early Admission applicants must meet at least two of the following three criteria:
 - ACT composite score of 25 or above or another equivalent standardized college entrance test score
 - Minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 3.8 on a 4.0 scale
 - High school rank in the upper 20% of their graduating class

Direct Admission from High School (includes applicants with less than 25 college credits)

1. ACT minimum score: 20
2. Rank: Upper 50% of graduating class or GED requirement
3. Cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0

Suggested course work:

- English - 8 semesters (2 semesters in Composition)
- Math - 6 semesters (2 semesters in Algebra)
- Science - 6 semesters (2 semesters in Biology)
- Social Studies - 6 semesters

Transfer Applicants

- Applicants with 1-24 college credits must meet High School Criteria and have a minimum college cumulative GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale).
- Applicants with 25 or more earned college credits must have a minimum college cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale).
- Earn grade of C- or higher in all prescribed general education courses.

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove [English proficiency](#) prior to admission review.
