

# APPLICATION MATERIALS

## Accelerated Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)

The Accelerated BSN program begins each year in the summer and fall semesters. All required application materials must be received before admission consideration. Review of completed applicant files begins after the priority date. The process requires 6–8 weeks. Applications received after the priority date will be reviewed on a rolling basis.

### Priority Dates

Summer Cohort: September 1

Fall Cohort: February 1

### The following application materials must be submitted:

2. Non-refundable \$50 application fee
3. Official transcripts from all colleges attended  
*Transcripts from outside the United States must be evaluated by [Educational Perspectives](#) as a [Catalog Match](#). If a Catalog Match is not completed, the evaluation will NOT meet the requirement*
4. Official AP score report if applicable
5. Two [academic or professional references](#)
6. Complete the current version of [ATI – Test of Essential Academic Skills \(TEAS\)](#).  
Performance determines academic readiness for the program

Applying from another nursing program requires a [letter of good standing](#) from the previous institution to be considered for admission.

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove [English proficiency](#) prior to admission consideration.
