

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

BSN–DNP

The BSN-DNP program begins in the fall and spring semesters. All required application materials must be received prior to admission consideration. Completed applicant files are reviewed on a rolling basis. The review process requires six to eight weeks.

The following criterion must be met for admission consideration:

- A bachelor's degree in nursing from a school accredited by a regional accrediting organization
- A minimum undergraduate grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale in the last 60 hours of college coursework
- RN Licensure from Iowa or a [Nurse Licensure Compact \(NLC\)](#) state
- Completion of a course in statistics

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove [English proficiency](#) prior to admission review.

Meeting admission criteria does not guarantee admission into the program. Allen College uses a holistic admission review. The process balances academic achievement, work experience, extra-curricular involvement, leadership, community service, diversity, as well as, other applicable life experiences. Top applicants are accepted each term.
