

APPLICATION MATERIALS

Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT)

The DPT program begins each year in the spring semester. All required application materials must be received prior to admission consideration. Complete applicant files are reviewed on a rolling basis. The review process requires six to eight weeks.

The following application materials must be submitted:

1. [Application](#).
2. Non-refundable \$50.00 application fee.
3. Official transcripts from all colleges attended sent directly from the institution(s) to Allen College.
4. Two recommendations from professionals addressing ability to be academically successful as well as personal/professional characteristics. Letters should come from a college/university counselor/advisor/faculty member, or a physical therapist supervising volunteer/work experience, and/or faculty advisor for college/university club or organization.
5. GRE (Graduate Record Examination) scores using code 6065.
6. [Observation/experience](#) totaling 50 hours under the supervision of a physical therapist signed and verified by a physical therapist.
7. Applicants whose first language is not English must prove [English proficiency](#) prior to admission review. The TOEFL exam is also required.

Meeting admission criteria does not guarantee admission into the program. Allen College uses a holistic admission review. The process balances academic achievement, work experience, extra-curricular involvement, leadership, community service, diversity, as well as, other applicable life experiences. Top applicants are accepted each term.
