

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Doctor of Education in Health Professions (Ed.D.)

The Ed.D. option begins each year in the fall and spring. Applications will not be considered until all required materials are received. Review of complete applicant files occurs on a rolling basis. The process requires 6–8 weeks.

Rolling Admission

The following criterion must be met:

- Have a master's or higher academic degree from a regionally accredited institution
- A minimum graduate grade point average (GPA) of 3.00 on a 4.00 scale
- Completion of a course in statistics
- An interview may be required

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove [English proficiency](#) prior to admission review.

Meeting admission criteria does not guarantee admission into the program. Allen College uses a holistic admission review. The process balances academic achievement, work experience, extra-curricular involvement, leadership, community service, diversity, as well as, other applicable life experiences. Top applicants are accepted each term.
