APPLICATION MATERIALS

Medical Imaging (MI)

The Medical Imaging program begins once each year in the fall. Required application materials can be <u>submitted as they are completed</u>, <u>but all materials must be received before admission consideration</u>. Completed applicant files are reviewed on a rolling basis. The process requires 3 to 4 weeks.

The following materials must be submitted through the application portal:

- 1. Online Application Form
- 2. Non-refundable \$50 application fee

The following materials must be emailed to admissions@allencollege.edu:

- 3. Early Admission applicants only: Official high school transcript
- 4. Official transcripts from all colleges attended Transcripts from outside the United States must be evaluated by <u>Educational</u> <u>Perspectives</u> as a <u>Catalog Match</u>. If a Catalog Match is not completed, the evaluation will NOT meet the requirement
- 5. Official AP score report using code 3610, if applicable

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove <u>English proficiency</u> prior to admission consideration.

Meeting admission criteria does not guarantee admission into the program. Allen College uses a holistic admission review. The process balances academic achievement, work experience, extracurricular involvement, leadership, community service, diversity, as well as, other applicable life experiences. Top applicants are accepted each term.
