

ADMISSIONS DEADLINES

Master of Science in Occupational Therapy (MS in OT)

The MS in OT program begins each year in the fall. Applicants can apply to the program prior to completion of all prerequisite coursework; however, all admissions requirements need to be completed before matriculation. Required application materials must be received prior to admission consideration. Completed applicant files received by November 1 will be reviewed for priority selection. After the priority deadline, applicant files are assessed on a rolling basis. The selection process requires an interview prior to admission.

Priority Deadline: November 1

OTCAS applications must be “verified” by the priority deadline to be considered for priority selection. Therefore, it is recommended OTCAS applications be submitted 2-3 weeks (no later than October 18) ahead of the deadline to allow the time for OTCAS to verify all materials.
