

# APPLICATION MATERIALS

## Master of Science in Occupational Therapy (MS in OT)

The MS in OT option begins once each year in the fall. Applications will not be considered until all required materials are received. Review of complete applicant files begins after the priority date. The review process requires an interview prior to admission.

### Priority Date

November 1

#### The following application materials must be submitted:

1. [Allen College application](#) or [OTCAS application](#) (OTCAS applications due October 18)
2. Non-refundable \$50.00 application fee
3. Official transcripts from all colleges attended sent directly from the college(s) to Allen College
4. Two [recommendations](#) from Academic or Professional representatives
5. Completed [Job Shadowing Forms](#) from two different sites **OR** [documentation](#) of [Online Shadowing Experience](#) created by Cheryl B. Lucas, EdD, OTR/L from Quinnipiac University (*password: LUCASQU*)
6. Current personal resume
7. Official AP score report if applicable
8. Applicants whose first language is not English must prove [English proficiency](#) prior to admission review.

*Meeting admission criteria does not guarantee an interview. Allen College uses a holistic admission review. The process balances academic achievement, work experience, extra-curricular involvement, leadership, community service, diversity, as well as, other applicable life experiences. Top applicants are accepted each year.*
