

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Public Health (PH)

The PH program begins twice each year in the fall and spring. All required application materials must be received before admission consideration. Review of complete applicant files begins after your file is complete. The process requires 3 to 4 weeks.

Rolling Admission

Early Admission

Early Admission allows outstanding high school students to request admission for a future term. Enrollment is granted for a specific semester. All admission criteria must be maintained, including satisfactory completion of required prerequisites prior to beginning the program. Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis.

The following criterion must be met for consideration:

- ACT composite score of 25 or equivalent standardized college entrance exam score
- Minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 3.8 on a 4.0 scale

Transfer Applicants

Transfer applicants must have earned 25 college credits prior to admission review

The following criterion must be met:

- A minimum grade point average of 2.7 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Grade C- or higher in prerequisite general education courses
- 72 general education hours must be completed before starting the program

Applicants whose first language is not English must prove [English proficiency](#) prior to admission consideration.

Meeting admission criteria does not guarantee admission into the program. Allen College uses a holistic admission review. The process balances academic achievement, work experience, extra-curricular involvement, leadership, community service, diversity, as well as, other applicable life experiences. Top applicants are accepted each term.
